VIDEO VISITATION RULES FOR ON-SITE VISITATION

1. All visits are recorded and subject to electronic monitoring by the Bastrop County Jail Staff.
2. Facility visitation rules as posted will apply.
3. On-Site visits may be scheduled in advance by the visitor from the Securus Video Visitation Website at <http://videovisitation.securustech.net/onsite>. Visitors must present **a valid, government-issued, photo identification**.
4. The duration of each visit is 20 minutes; each inmate is allowed two (2) on-site visits per week.
5. No more than two (2) visitors present for each visit.
6. Every visitor that scheduled their visit in advance must show up at least thirty (30) minutes prior to their scheduled visit. Visitors arriving late will not be allowed to visit.
7. Visitation dress code as posted in the lobby will be strictly enforced.
8. During a visit, the visitor is required to remain at the visitation booth. If the visitor leaves the visitation booth, the visit will be terminated.
9. Visitors appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted into the video visitation area and their visit will be cancelled.
10. Visitors under the age of 17 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
11. Visitors may only bring their identification and car keys into the visitation area. Cell phones, cameras or other electronic devices are prohibited.
12. Loud talking or any type of disruptive behavior will not be permitted.
13. Do not damage or deface the visitation equipment. Doing so may result in prosecution.
14. If you experience a problem with the audio or video reception during your visit, you are required to notify the visitation staff immediately.

Bastrop County Sheriff's Office reserves the right to deny, cancel or terminate a video visit prior to or during a video session based upon visitor or inmate misconduct. The Bastrop County Sheriff's Office also reserves the right to restrict a visitor from participating in all future use of the system, either on-site or for remote visitation.
